STAFFORD HAMLET COMMUNITY MEETING

Minutes

September 8, 2020

Chair Bill Markt called the September 8th Community meeting of the Stafford Hamlet to order at approximately 7:00 pm on Zoom.

Stafford Hamlet Volunteer Opportunities:

Bill Markt began by saying the Community meeting is dedicated to helping people learn how to get involved in the Stafford Hamlet and the Stafford Community Planning Organization (CPO).

Patty Mamula gave a presentation about volunteer opportunities in the Hamlet. Patty started by talking about what is at stake and why the Hamlet needs volunteers and help. Issues that affect Hamlet residents include the City of Tualatin's interest in delineating areas of interest for future development, West Linn-Wilsonville Schools's estimate of 24,000 future housing units to be added, the widening on I-205, and the cost of future infrastructure in the build-out in the Hamlet area. Patty also shared the Community Vision Plan (CVP),

Patty Mamula detailed several ways to get involved. She invited people to apply for the Hamlet Board. There are ten Board members, each elected for two years, and prospective members must live in or own property in the Hamlet area. The Community Planning Organization is also in need of at least two to four new Board members. Neighborhood Captains are also needed. One person from each of the 15 neighborhoods is what is being sought. Other ways to get involved are city council liaisons. The Hamlet is looking for one to two people per city, and the liaisons would attend meetings, provide comment from the Hamlet, and inform the Hamlet of issues that affect the area. The Hamlet is also looking for a liaison to the West Linn-Wilsonville School District. The Hamlet is also looking to add a high school student to the Hamlet Board as a student representative, and the student representative would also choose one committee to participate in.

The Hamlet is also seeking assistance with the website, the newsletter, social media accounts, communications committee, and the Hamlet Futuring Committee. There are many positions open for volunteers for the Family Fest.

People who are interested in volunteering should contact Patty Mamula or Bill Markt.

A community member asked if the volunteer opportunities will be on the website. Jana Lombardi said that most of the opportunities should be on the website. Patty Mamula said the powerpoint that she used tonight is on the Hamlet website as well.
